Externship Overview:

Catholic Charities Diocese of Arlington is pleased to announce a Pre-Doctoral Externship in Clinical Psychology for the 2025-2026 Training Year. We are looking for 3-4 externs split between two offices to provide psychotherapy as well as conduct assessment batteries for the clinical communities that we serve. Training opportunities include clinical experience working with individual adults, children, adolescents, couples, and families as well as psychological, psychoeducational, and vocational assessments.

Externs will provide 10 to 12 hours of outpatient psychotherapy weekly in a central clinic (travel required), as well as conduct psychological assessments. One hour of individual supervision will be provided weekly by a licensed clinical psychologist.

Additional training opportunities such as didactics, group supervision, and assessment supervision are available through Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Arlington Extern Training Consortium.

The training year will begin in August 2025 and end in June 2026 for qualified applicants to receive training in Clinical Psychology.
