<p>Placement for externs interested in pediatric psychology and provision of psychological services to children with range of chronic mental health and/or medical illness as well as behavioral regulatory difficulties. Externs will get experience providing individual therapy, group therapy, psychological evaluations, developmental evaluations and behavioral management plans. The placement includes primarily outpatient services with as needed inpatient medical consultations for infants receiving medical services. Externs will provide evaluations to children ages 5 through 21 years of age. Externs can participate/observe early intervention, feeding modules and related rehabilitation services. 20 hours per week of externship is expected. One psychological evaluation per month and 6-8 face-to-face clinical hours per week is expected. Individual supervision is scheduled weekly. Group supervision and case presentations are scheduled each semester. Externs should expect to have live supervision and/or have telehealth sessions observed during the initial months of training and as needed for the duration of training. Externs also have access to didactic seminars held at the Baltimore campus (via Zoom or in person). Since the COVID-19 Pandemic psychotherapy services are largely provided using telehealth; however, patients have the option for in-person services. All Psychological Assessments are in-person.</p>
